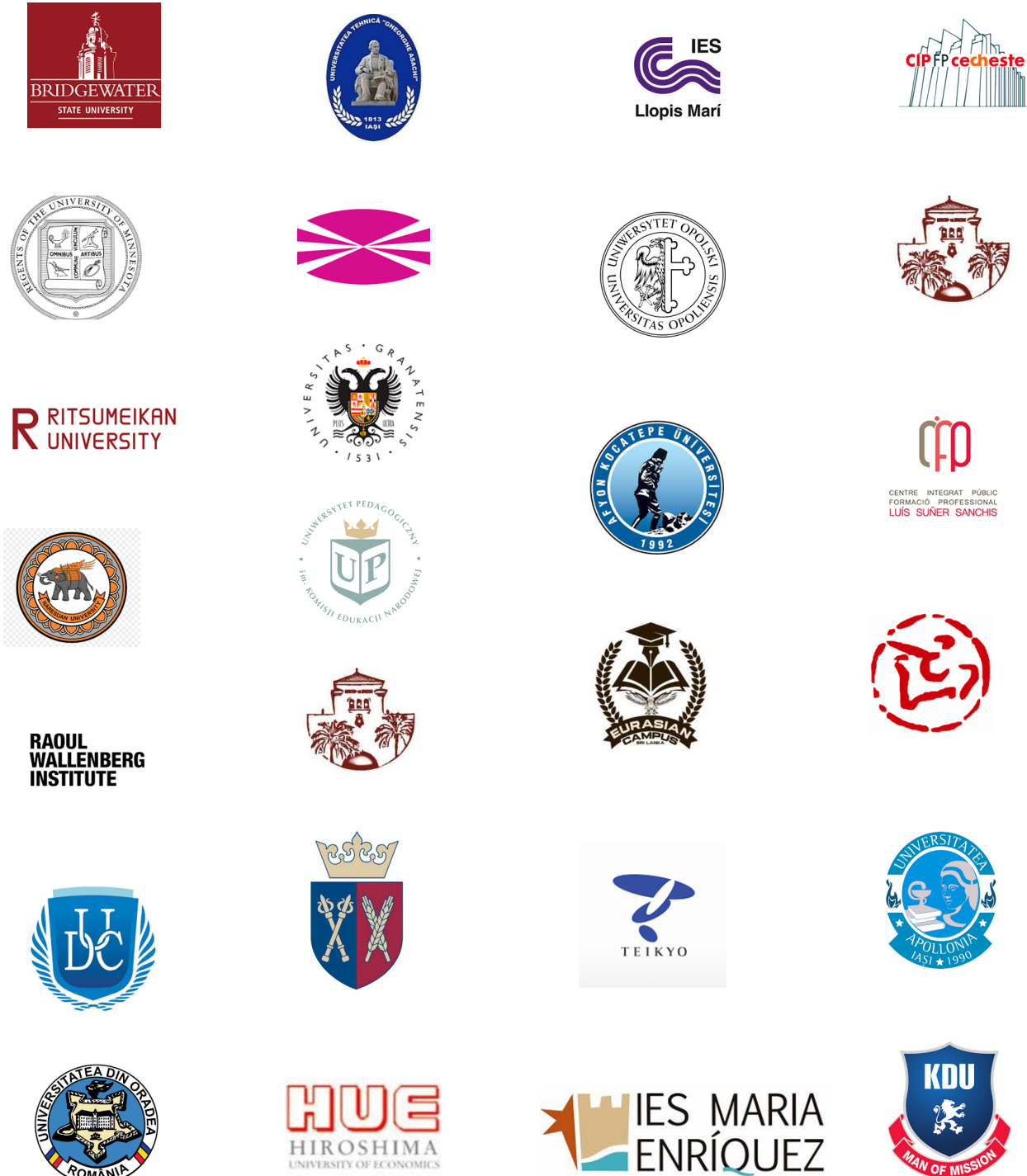
# PUC has established partnerships with leading universities and organizations across Asia, Europe, and the USA

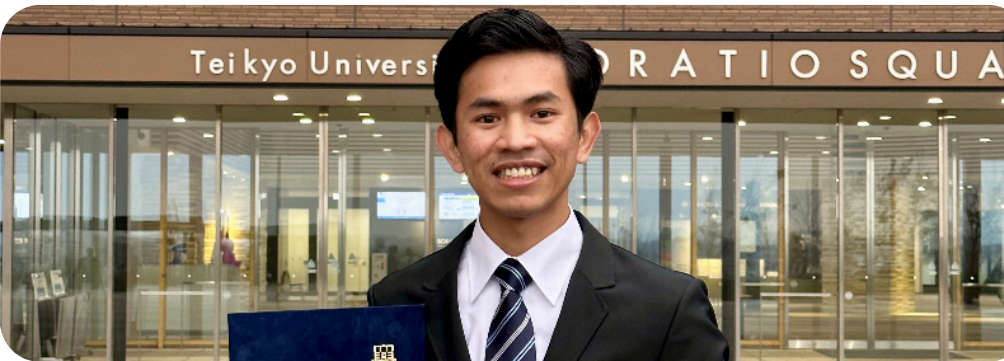


DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM

PUC aims to develop mutual benefits from cooperation with other universities abroad, and can offer students the opportunity to pursue higher degrees in other countries, where full scholarships are available.

So far, PUC has cooperated and signed MOUs and MOAs on dual degree programs with some universities, including Teikyo University in Japan, Canberra University in Australia, and Kyungdong University in South Korea.

Specifically, Teikyo University has been continuing to offer full scholarships to PUC students since 2015. The full scholarship also includes financial coverage for the round-trip tickets, health insurance, living accommodations, and a monthly allowance.
